
The District will receive public comments on the proposed Desired Future Conditions for the relevant aquifers in the NTVGCD through 2080 expressed as average drawdown for the Carrizo Wilcox Aquifer: Anderson County, 180 feet; Cherokee County, 177 feet; and Henderson County, 155 feet.
